State Laws Can Impact Families



The Tennessee legislature’s annual session is in full swing. Our legislators will be asked to vote on a number of matters that will affect our culture either for good or ill and, as a consequence, affect families. Below are just a few bills related to the family and religious liberty that our legislators are considering:

- **SJR 127:** This proposed amendment to the state constitution would again make it neutral on abortion, reversing the state Supreme Court’s ruling that abortion is a right.
- **SB0078/HB605:** This bill would “reverse” an opinion of the state’s Attorney General that opened the door to two unmarried, cohabitating individuals (homosexual and heterosexual) adopting, putting children in the middle of relationships that are generally unstable. The opinion may compel Christian adoption agencies to place children in such homes.
- **SB1283/HB1598:** This bill, modeled after the federal Religious Freedom Protection Act, would help protect individuals and organizations from state and local laws and regulations that infringe on their First Amendment right to the free exercise of religion.
- **SB0662/HB1139:** This bill would create state-wide standards for the operation of businesses in the adult entertainment industry.
